Statement from Jan-Philipp Beck, EIT Health CEO

19 March 2020

Dear Partners of EIT Health,

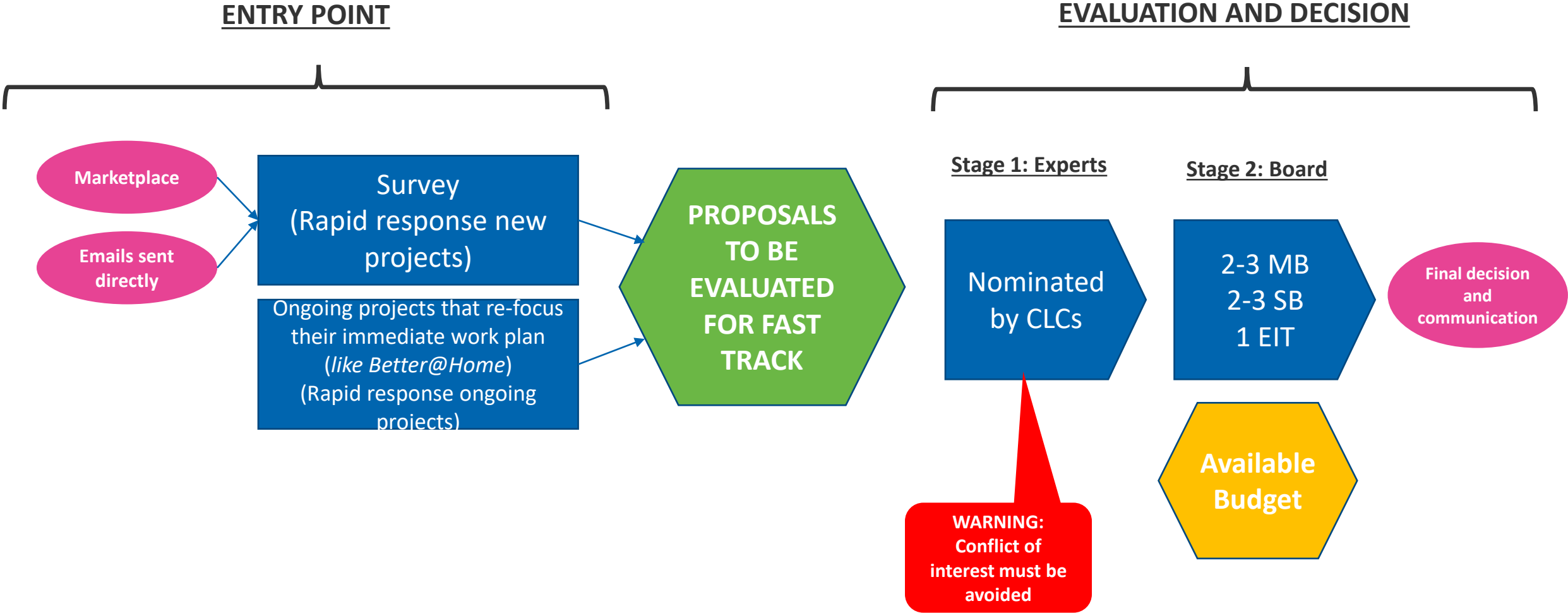

- To share and amplify these activities via EIT Health channels and facilitate their connections.

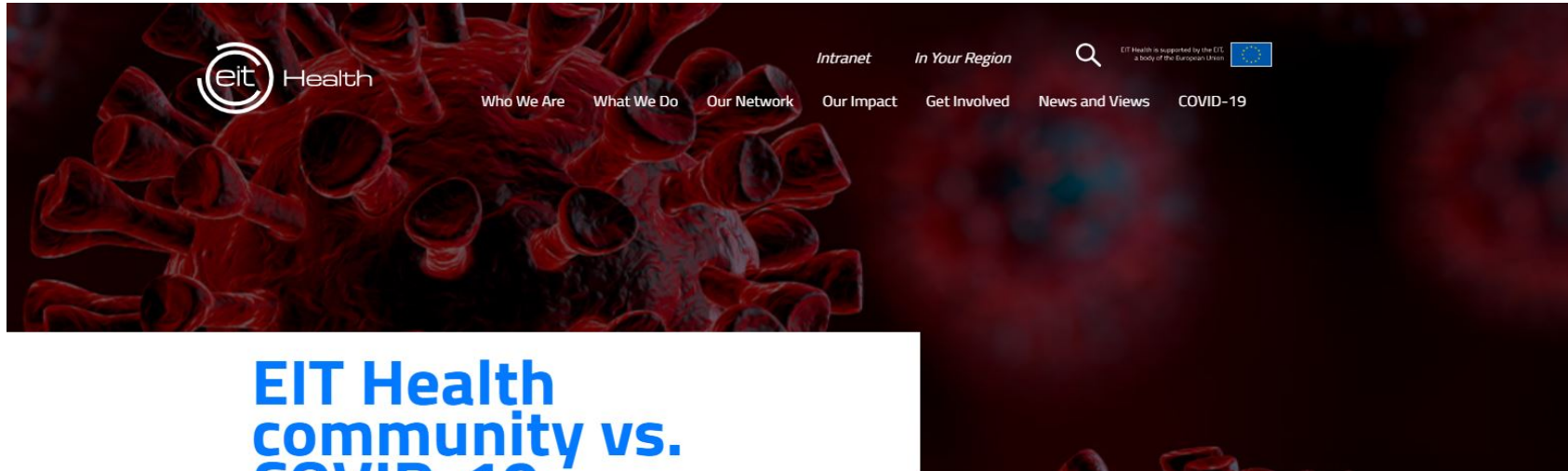

ACTIONS:

- Sharing the experience of the Madrid and Catalan government apps for checking symptoms, monitoring and tracking patients of Covid-19.
- Sharing the experience of 3D printed emergency ventilators.
- Providing contacts and consultancy to check the feasibility of connecting a 4x1 respirator.
- Supporting local running projects in short-term actions such as: Better@Home (home hospitalisation for corona-pneumonia), Value (re-shape of emergencies at SERMAS), HEALTHYLONELINESS (support for elderly people at home), D-Health (reshape ICUs)...

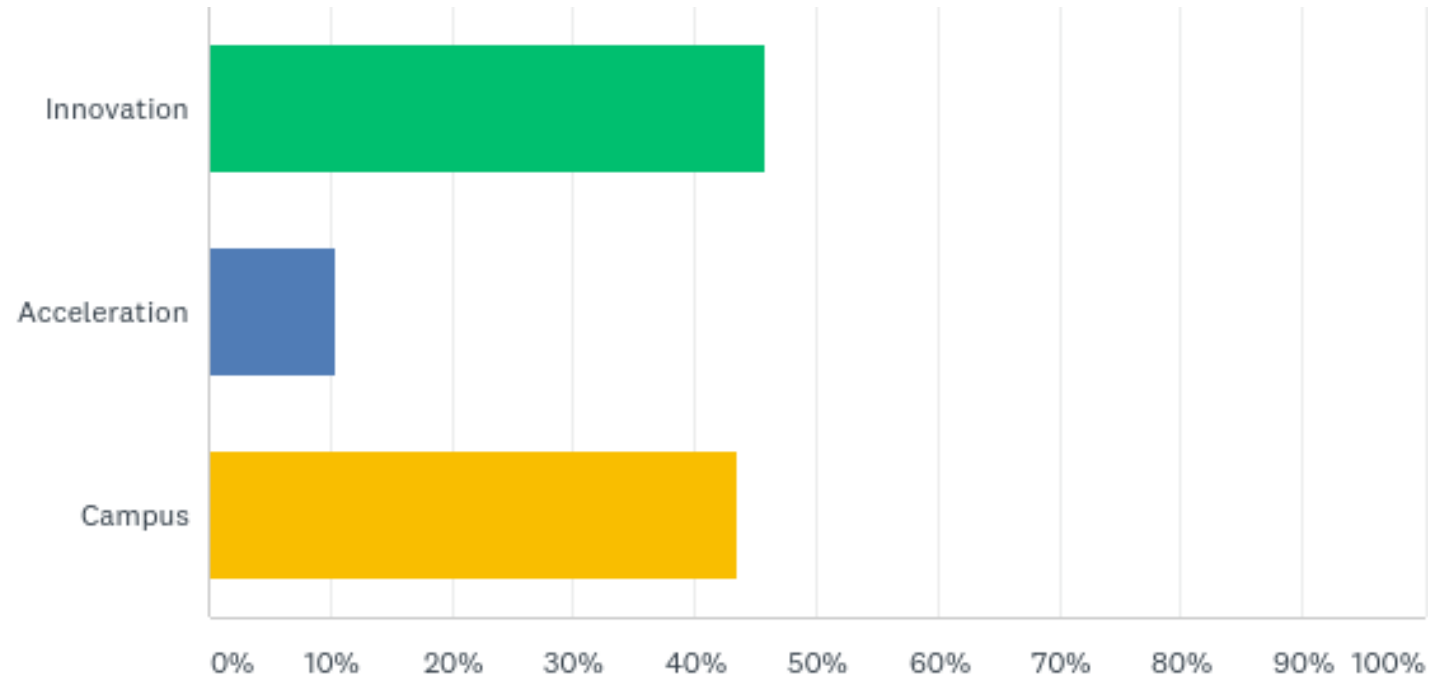

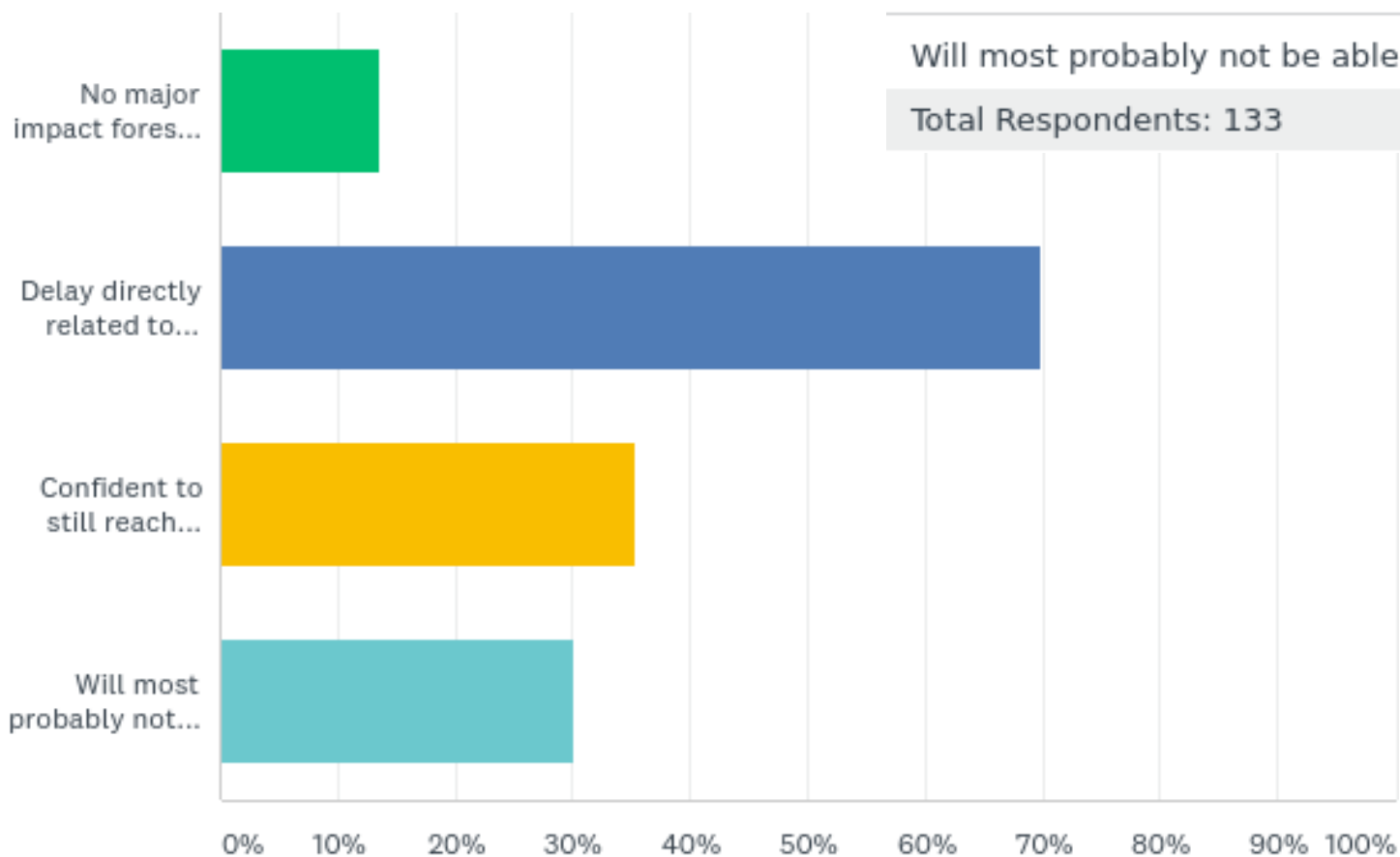

Q2: How will the current pandemic situation will influence your project progress? (multiple checks possible)

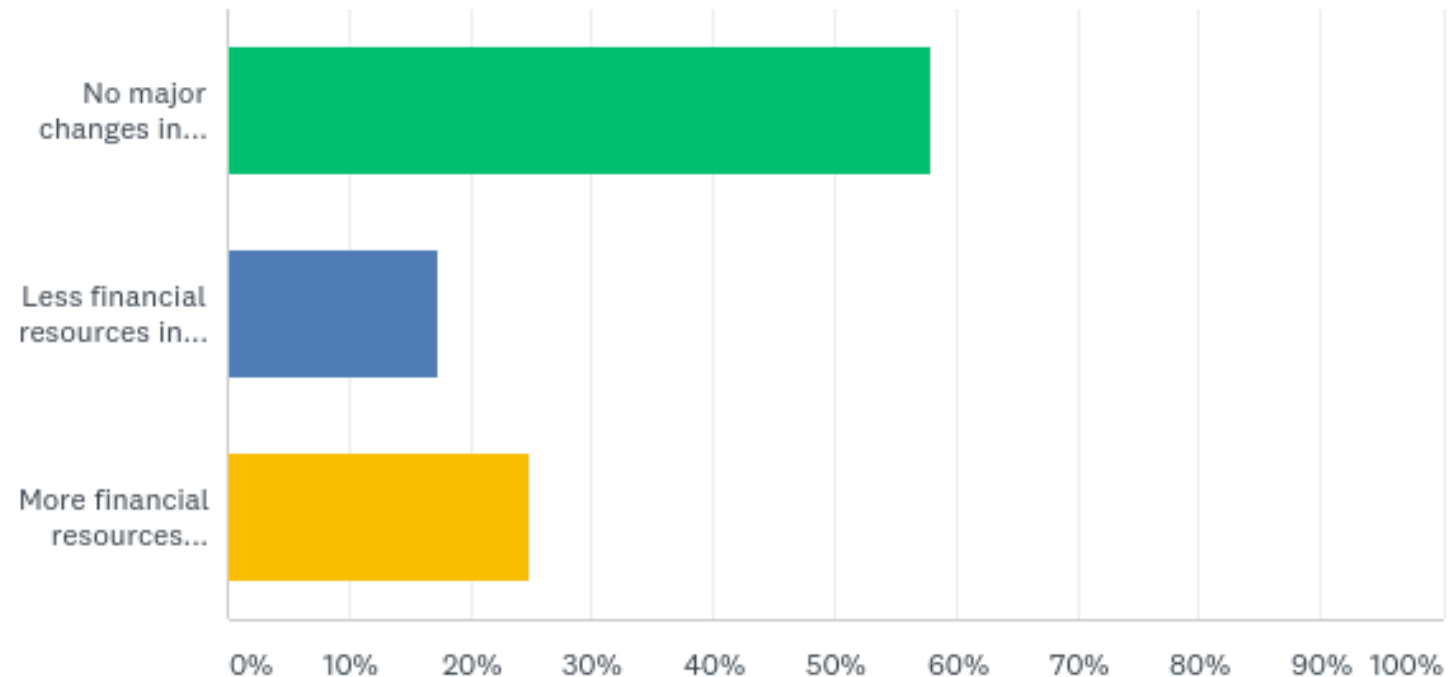

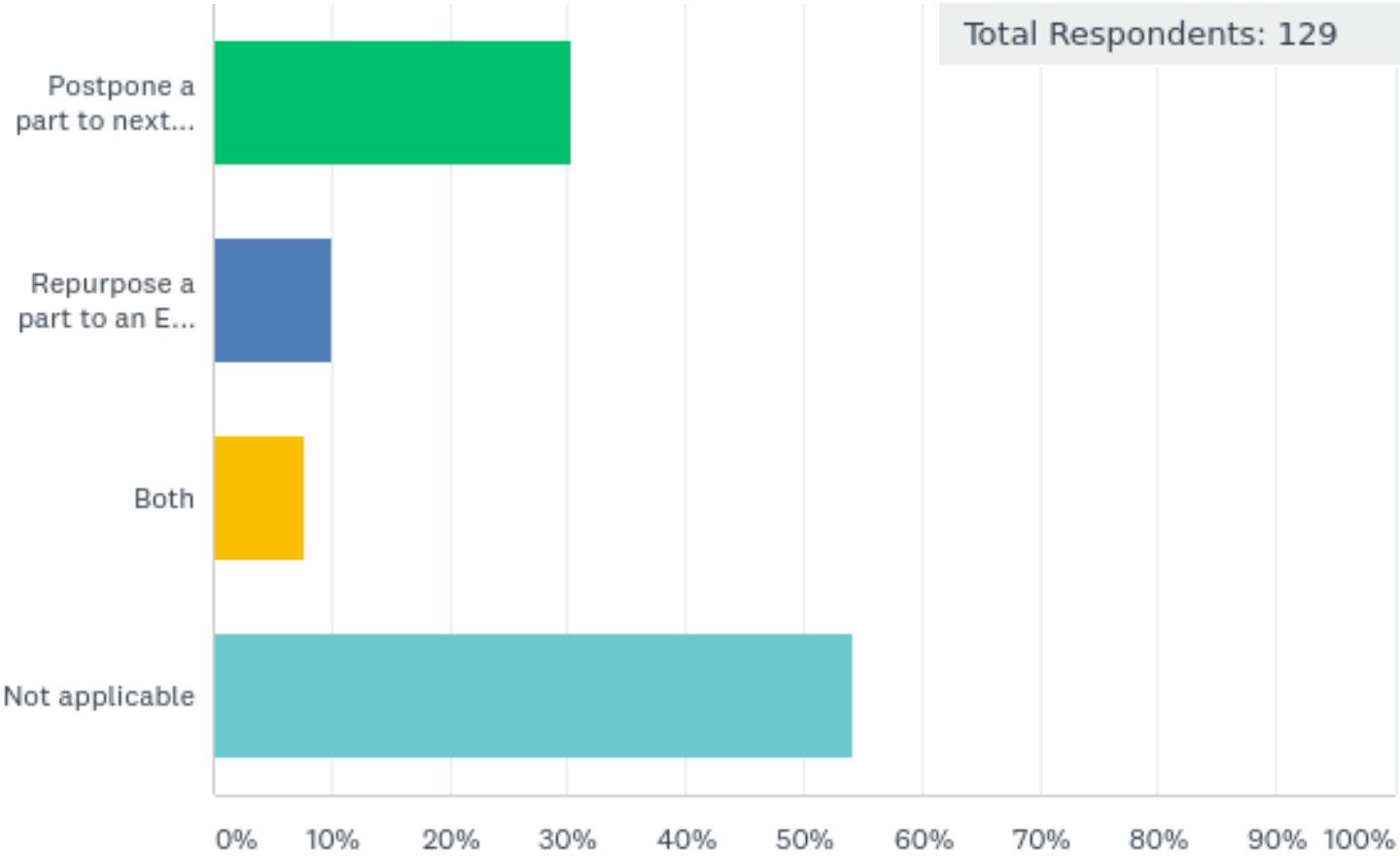
Q3: How will it impact the financing of your project? (please check only one answer)

What is needed from the field experience

Priorisation from CLC Spain Task Force

- Epidemiology -> TM Apps (Corea Model)
 - Contagious rate, mortality rates
 - Contagious maps
- Epidemiology -> Real-Time AI to assess risk factors
 - Early identification of patients which will evolve to a critical state
- Treatments, vaccins and diagnostics (specially POC!!!!)
 - Short time, easier test to make triage at emergency care. It can reduce hours of waiting and collapsing emergencies
 - Target producto profile (TPP) of diagnostic Kits
 - Better test that can be done outside hospital and at home
- Technology for IC
 - Ventilators
- Logistics
 - Mobility of supplies. Douanes/Bureaucracy
- Logistics
 - Cleaning robots
 - Desinfection processes
- Remote care for vulnerable population at home (elderly)
- Fighting fake news
- Wellbeing, exercise and psychological support for long-term isolation
- Faster adoption of innovations. Process innovation

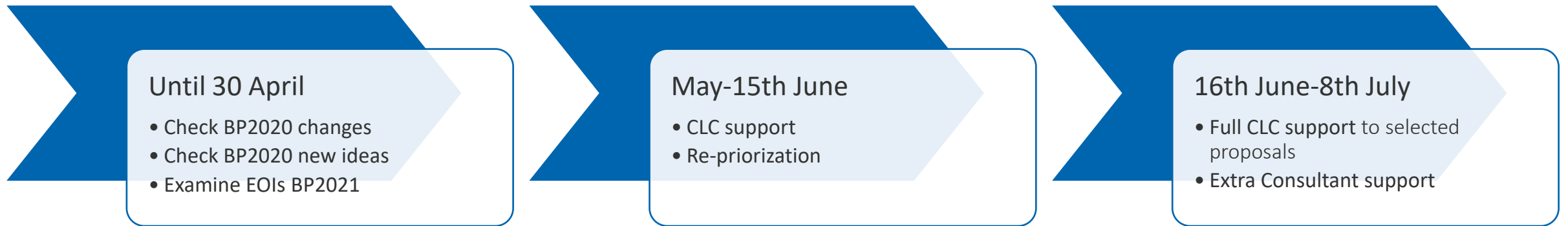
BP2021: Deadline 8th July (Deadline for EOI 27th May)

Clarifications

- COVID-19 projects
 - It is not a separate call
 - There is not a separate financing source
 - EOI is requested by end May (no written feedback from CLC, but oral). Criteria of eligibility.
 - CLC Will prioritize only very few
 - There will be portfolio management
- REST of projects
 - Not accepted new ideas or new EOIs
 - Compete in same portfolio
